We are pleased to announce that we have set up a 'recycle 4 school' recycling initiative with **Roberts Recycling Ltd** in order to raise funds for our school.

**Roberts Recycling Ltd** is an award winning company and one of the UK's leading clothes recyclers and exporters. This recycling initiative will allow us to raise funds, recycle and benefit people in poorer parts of the world at the same time. We will receive **£500 per ton** collected.

We are kicking off this initiative with a big collection on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June to coincide with sports day. However, we have also set up a permanent collection box in the school reception area where you can drop items off at your convenience.

We will be sending collection bags home with the children over the next few days. Simply fill the bag provided with clothes, paired shoes, bags and belts (you can use any other plastic bag if you need to) and either bring it along to sports day on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June or drop it off in the recycling box in reception. All items **must** be in reusable condition (so please don't include anything that's ripped or stained). A full list of what is and isn't accepted is attached below.
